**Dear Members of St. Joseph's,**

Two weeks ago we announced at both St. Mary's and St. Joseph's that Fr. Jim Leary, ofm Cap. would be coming at the end of August to be the Pastor of both parishes. He will be assisted by another priest who will be the Associate Pastor of both parishes. At this time we are unable to announce who this person will be.

I am writing this in our bulletin because I and members of St. Joseph's and St. Mary's staffs continue to get the question, "Have they received word yet on who the new Pastor of St. Mary's will be?" Hopefully this note will enlighten people who were not around the weekend of July 10th and 11th. Feel free to share this information with your friends.

Father Jim is presently on vacation for about 6 weeks. He will take over as pastor of both parishes on September 1st. Fr. Jim's last assignment was as pastor of St. Patrick's Church in Sparta, Wisconsin. Previous to that he was the Director of our Capuchin Soup Kitchens in Detroit. His first pastorate was at St. Mary Magdalene Parish in Hazel Park, Michigan. Jim is originally from St. Stephen's parish in Steven's Point, WI.

I especially want to emphasize that this is not a merger of St. Mary's and St. Joe's. The term used by the Diocesan Offices is that the two parishes will be "linked." Both parishes will remain autonomous and there is no plan in the future to bring the two parishes together as one.

In the past we have worked together very closely. Hopefully a common pastor for both parishes will continue to sprout new efforts. Fr. Jim comes with a wealth of experience and talent. I ask you to support him and the associate with your prayers and cooperation. Thank you.
